- c. list of all subjects (courses) the student has completed confirmed by the university (college) where the student completed them
- d. authorized translation of the above-mentioned list of completed subjects (courses)
- e. document proving that the university (college) the applicant has graduated from has accredited study programmes

# Applicants who will finish their bachelor's studies in the academic year 2019/2020 will submit the following documents:

- a. list of all subjects (courses) the student has completed confirmed by the university (college) where the student completed them
- b. authorized translation of the above-mentioned list of completed subjects (courses)
- c. document proving that the university (college) the applicant is going to graduate from has accredited study programmes
- d. notification of the term the applicant will obtain the Bachelor's or Master's Diploma from the university (college)
